Pura Tuluk Biyu Batur also known as Parahyangan Agung Pucak Gunung Abang, is one of Bali's Kahyangan Jagat, the small circle of temples considered most sacred and universally revered across the island, worshipped by the Hindu community of Bali for over nine centuries.

In September 2026, the temple's Pengempon (customary caretakers and congregation) will hold the Karya Agung Madewasraya, a great ceremony of renewal and purification held only rarely, once every few decades. It is a significant undertaking for the community, and one that depends on the generosity of donors and partners beyond the temple's own resources.

01 About the Temple

Pura Tuluk Biyu Batur is believed to have existed since before the 11th century, when it stood at Air Hawang, in what is now Desa Abang. Its long history is documented in 21 sacred copper-plate inscriptions (prasasti), the earliest dated to 1011 CE and the latest to 1384 CE spanning the Warmadewa dynasty through the Majapahit era, and confirming centuries of royal patronage and continuous worship.

The temple is dedicated to Bhatara Kulit Biyu, revered as the “Lord of the Mountain” in Old Javanese cosmology, an aspect of Shiva as Ruler of the Mountain (Siwa Girinatha), paired with the mountain goddess Parwati Dewi. Today, Pura Tuluk Biyu Batur remains a living Kahyangan Jagat: a temple of universal significance sustained by its local community, and supported by Hindu devotees throughout Bali.

02 Purpose & Objectives

This request for support is made so that the temple's congregation can carry out the Karya Agung Madewasraya in accordance with the Balinese Hindu philosophy of Tri Hita Karana, harmony between people, nature, and the divine. Specifically, the ceremony aims to:

- I** Renew and strengthen devotion (sradha bhakti) to Ida Sang Hyang Widhi / God, who is enshrined at Pura Tuluk Biyu Batur.
- II** Ease the financial burden currently carried by the temple's own officials and congregation (Pengempon).
- III** Sustain the practice of Hindu religious tradition through a rare, large-scale ceremony of purification and renewal.

03 The Ceremony

The Karya Agung Madewasraya is a “Karya Agung” a great ceremony, the highest scale of ritual observed in Balinese Hindu temple life, typically held only once every several decades. It involves an extensive series of offerings (banten), ceremonial animals, and rites led by high priests (sulinggih), supported by the entire temple congregation and coordinated across three surrounding villages.

04 Budget Overview

The total estimated cost of the ceremony is Rp 3,500,135,000 (approximately USD 215,000). The largest share of the budget goes toward ceremonial offerings and ritual items, followed by ceremonial animals used in traditional rites, with a small remainder for supporting materials and structures.
